Dear Mr. Brown:

On October 28, 2011, you submitted for filing on behalf of Southwest Power Pool, Inc. (SPP), revisions to SPP's Open Access Transmission Tariff updating offer caps for all pivotal resources in SPP's energy imbalance service market for the year 2012. Pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – Central under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, your submittal in the above referenced docket is accepted for filing to become effective January 1, 2012.

Notice of the filing was issued on October 28, 2011, with comments, protests, or interventions due on or before November 18, 2011. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Under 18 C.F.R. § 385.210, interventions are timely if made within the time prescribed by the Secretary. Under 18 C.F.R. § 385.214, the filing of a timely motion to intervene makes the movant a party to the proceeding, if no answer in opposition is filed within fifteen days. The filing of a timely notice of intervention makes a State Commission a party to the proceeding.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against any of the applicant(s).

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This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
