Agenda Item 1, Call to Order

Micha greeted members and displayed the MP Testing iHedge v3.1 Test Cases.

Agenda Item 2, Roll Call

Roll was accounted for based on WebEx Attendance. John Seck of KMEA was the only member who identified himself as being on the call, but not on WebEx.

Purpose of Meeting

Micha Bailey welcomed all attendees and stated the purpose of the meeting was to discuss any concerns that had arisen for members during the testing process.

Agenda Item 3, Question & Answer

Question 1: The round cap does not change when I toggle between the Stage 1 and Stage 2 tabs in the ARR Nominations editor. Is this cap just for Stage 1 or does it include Stage 2?

Answer 1: The round cap includes both Stage 1 and Stage 2. It is the total cap that can be nominated in Round 1 of the monthly ARR Allocation.

Question 2: In Stage 2, when the Nominated % is multiplied by the remaining nomination cap, it is possible that the MW value can be less than the minimum allowed nomination of 0.1MW. What happens in this case?

Answer 2: When the MW nomination is less than 0.1 MW, the nomination is truncated to 0MW and is not included in the SFT calculations. For this reason, members should bear in mind that there is risk associated with small percentage nominations, as the nomination may be too small to be included.

Question 3: The nomination templates for Stage 1 and Stage 2 of the Monthly ARR Allocation have the same name when downloaded. We would like this to be changed to include the stage number as well.

Answer 3: SPP will provide a report on this software change at the August CWG meeting.

Question 4: What are the limitations put upon nominations in Stage 1 and Stage 2 of the monthly Allocation once the TCR 3.1 release is in production?

Answer 4: Members are permitted to submit up to 2000 nominations combined for PTP and NITS in Round 1 Stage 2, per peak of the Monthly ARR Allocation. In Stage 2 members may submit percentage nominations up to 100% for PTP on peak, PTP off peak, NITS on peak and NITS off peak.

Question 5: When manually adding or removing a candidate, the error message currently refers to round 3. Please update this to refer to the appropriate round/stage.

Answer 5: SPP will report on this chance at the August CWG meeting.
