RE: Withdrawal of Notification to Construct Approved Reliability Network Upgrades

Dear Mr. Dowling,

On June 21, 2019, Southwest Power Pool, Inc. ("SPP") originally issued NTC 210517 to Midwest Energy, Inc. ("MIDW"). This NTC is being re-issued to correct the study date and Service Agreement execution dates and supersedes the previously-issued NTC.

Pursuant to Section 3.3 of the SPP Membership Agreement and Attachments O and Y of the SPP Open Access Transmission Tariff ("OATT"), SPP provides this Notification to Construct ("NTC") directing Midwest Energy, Inc. ("MIDW"), as the Designated Transmission Owner, to construct the Network Upgrade(s).

On May 8, 2019, SPP concluded that the Network Upgrade listed below should be withdrawn and informed the Project Cost Working Group of the withdrawal on June 5, 2019 in accordance with SPP Business Practice 7060 Section 7.1. MIDW executed their updated Service Agreement without this upgrade on June 24, 2019.
