

2020 ITP Schedule Changes and Updated DPP Window Information

- Informational Posting – No Action Required**

The 2020 ITP needs assessment posting rescheduled for March 19, 2020, has been delayed due to additional analysis and economic runs required during the constraint assessment rework. This impacts the posting dates and approvals for the other 2020 ITP milestones listed below, leading up to the needs assessment posting. The 2020 ITP base reliability powerflow and short-circuit models were not impacted and will not change. Stakeholders will be given the opportunity to review these updated final models and re-approval will be requested. These changes will be presented at the [Transmission Working Group \(TWG\) net conference tomorrow, March 4](#). Impacts to the 2021 ITP will be evaluated and further information provided as soon as available.
