

2021 ITP Resource Plan - Phase 2 (Zonal Shortfalls)

- Action Required**

The 2021 Integrated Transmission Planning Assessment (ITP) Resource Plan - Phase 2 (Zonal Shortfall) workbook has been posted to [GlobalScape](#) to allow additional time to review the information in advance of the final Resource Plan Phase 2 posting. These preliminary shortfalls include the accreditation resulting from the implementation of Effective Load Carrying Capability (ELCC) as discussed in the 2021 ITP Scope. ELCC amounts have been determined using the SAWG-developed ELCC studies for wind, solar, and energy storage resources. The capacity shortfalls and the recommended conventional resource plan will be discussed further at the [May 7, 2020 ESWG meeting](#).

A separate posting with the recommended Resource Plan Phase 2 will be posted to [GlobalScape](#) and included in the ESWG background materials later this week.
