The 2021 Integrated Transmission Planning Assessment (ITP) Internal Resource Plan - Phase 2 (Final) workbook has been posted to [GlobalScape](#). The Internal Resource Plan Phase 2 identifies the capacity needs of the SPP system and recommends conventional resource additions for each zone to ensure its reserve margin requirements can be met throughout the 2021 ITP Assessment horizon.
