

2020 ITP Draft Project List

- **Action Required**

SPP staff requests stakeholders review the initial 2020 ITP draft project list and provide feedback. The draft list of projects for the 2020 ITP has been posted to [GlobalScape](#). This project list is reflective of the top-ranking projects SPP staff has identified to solve 2020 ITP needs and the projects for which SPP has sent out for study-level cost estimates. Please note that the list of projects being considered and the needs associated with the posted projects may change as portfolio development progresses.

Staff did not request study-level cost estimates to comprehensively address the SPS South and SPP/MISO Coordinated System Plan needs but will continue to evaluate these needs using SPP’s conceptual estimates. SPP has included multiple Extra High Voltage solutions in the Oklahoma City area, but will continue analysis to fully understand the impacts on the underlying system.
