Pursuant to Section 3.3 of the Southwest Power Pool, Inc. ("SPP") Membership Agreement and Attachments O and Y of the SPP Open Access Transmission Tariff ("OATT"), SPP provides this Notification to Construct ("NTC") directing Evergy Metro, Inc. ("EM"), as the Designated Transmission Owner, to construct the Network Upgrade(s).

On October 27, 2020, the SPP Board of Directors approved the Network Upgrade(s) listed below to be withdrawn.
