Order 2222 Task Force

Organizational Group Scope Statement
December 8, 2020

PURPOSE

The Order 2222 Task Force is responsible for developing the necessary changes to SPP's governing documents to comply with FERC's Order 2222, **Participation of Distributed Energy Resource Aggregations in Markets Operated by RTOs/ISOs**. Order No. 2222 was published in the **Federal Register**, [85 FR 67094](#), providing that: "Each RTO/ISO must file the tariff changes needed to implement the requirements of this final rule by July 19, 2021."

SCOPE OF ACTIVITIES

The Order 2222 Task Force will develop policy and accompanying changes to SPP's governing documents to enable the participation of DERs in SPP's market by providing a means for these resources to, in the aggregate, satisfy minimum size and performance requirements that they may not meet on a stand-alone basis as required by FERC Order No. 2222.

The Policy and accompanying Governing Documents addressing DER Aggregations must:

1. Allow DER Aggregations to participate directly in RTO/ISO market and establish DER Aggregators as a type of market participant;¹
2. Allow DER Aggregators to register DER aggregations under one or more participation models that accommodate the physical and operational characteristics of the DER aggregations;²
3. Establish a minimum size requirement for DER aggregations that does not exceed 100 kW;³
4. Address locational requirements for DER aggregations;⁴

5. Address distribution factors and bidding parameters for DER aggregations;⁵
6. Address information and data requirements for DER aggregations;⁶
7. Address metering and telemetry requirements for DER aggregations;⁷
8. Address coordination between the RTO or ISO, the DER Aggregator, the distribution utility, and the relevant electric retail regulatory authorities;⁸
9. Address modifications to the list of resources in a DER aggregation;⁹ and
10. Address market participation agreements for DER aggregators.¹⁰
