Organizational Group Scope
Statement June 2023

PURPOSE

The Generator Interconnection Advisory Group (GIAG) facilitates sharing information and gathering feedback related to the Generator Interconnection (GI) process administered by Southwest Power Pool (SPP). The GIAG relies on the collective knowledge of stakeholders and interested interconnection customers to assist in the development of policies and recommendations needed to improve GI services provided by SPP.

SCOPE OF ACTIVITIES

In carrying out its purpose, the GIAG:

1. Identifies GI process issues and inefficiencies.
2. Proposes improvements to GI processes, tools, business practices, or tariffs, along with supporting rationale, implementation costs and any tariff changes to mitigate GI issues.
3. Provides input and guidance on SPP staff or member proposed improvements to GI-related studies, agreements, governing documentation, and business functions.
4. Identifies opportunities and coordinates with other SPP stakeholder groups to address issues of common interest, such as transmission planning functions.
5. Advises on FERC Notices of Public Rulemaking, FERC Orders, and other policy level efforts related to GI.

REPRESENTATION

The GIAG is comprised of at least 8 representatives and no more than 16 representatives from SPP Member companies, including the chair and vice-chair, if one is appointed. The GIAG shall select a chair using the process defined in Section 3.3 of the Bylaws, however it has the discretion to determine the need for a vice-chair position.

GIAG representatives will be selected based on their experience and involvement in Generator Interconnection activities.



REPORTING

The GIAG provides, as needed, advice on GI-related matters to SPP Organizational Groups, other advisory groups, and user forums.
