Charter and Scope of Activities

November 4, 2021

PURPOSE

The System Operating Limits Methodology Task Force (SOLMTF) will review the newly proposed FAC-011 and FAC-014 standards and make necessary changes to the current SOL methodology and any related documents based on the new requirements.

SCOPE OF ACTIVITIES

In the course of reviewing the current SOL methodology, the SOLMTF will:

1. Review/compare other RC SOL methodologies for best practices and identify areas in where enhancements or improvements can be made.
2. Review the new standard requirements and assess if SPP/TOPs has the necessary software and tools to meet each requirement.
3. Determine if new processes, or tools are needed to comply with the new SOL methodology.
4. Recommended updates to the current SPP East SOL Methodology.

REPRESENTATION

SOLMTF membership consists of a minimum of 5 and up to 7 representative nominated by a current ORWG member, including the chair and vice-chair. Meetings are open, however the SOLMTF may limit attendance during specific portions of a meeting by an affirmative vote of the SOLMTF consistent with the SPP Bylaws.

DURATION

Temporary. The SOLMTF will be disbanded at the discretion of the Operating Reliability Working Group (ORWG).



REPORTING

The SOLMTF reports to the ORWG. The SOLMTF will be directed by the ORWG.
