

## 2022 ITP Updated Base Reliability (BR) Powerflow Proposed Final Model Information

- **Action Required**

The 2022 Integrated Transmission Planning Assessment (ITP) Proposed Final BR Powerflow models and supplemental data have been posted to [GlobalScape](#). SPP staff is posting these updated models for stakeholder awareness, review, and approval of the updated 2022 ITP BR Powerflow initial final Pass 3a models. Please verify topology is modeled appropriately.

**SPP staff will be requesting TWG approval of the updated final 2022 ITP BR Powerflow Proposed Final model information via email on February 2, 2022.**

As a reminder, the following Base Reliability models will be used for the 2022 ITP:

- 2024 Base Reliability Light Load, Summer, and Winter models
- 2027 Base Reliability Light Load, Summer, and Winter models
- 2032 Base Reliability Light Load, Summer, and Winter models

The 2021 series MDWG (MDAG) and 2022 ITP models were built in parallel; however, the models are posted separately. Please refer to the model build schedule located on the SPP corporate website under the MDAG page ([2021 Series MDWG \(MDAG\) Powerflow and Short Circuit Model Build](#)) for the different deadlines and milestones.
