

20-year Assessment (20YA) Site Repository Posting

- **Action Required**

SPP staff requests that stakeholders review the 20YA site repository and provide feedback. After stakeholder feedback is received and incorporated, this site repository will be used as a comprehensive list of sites for consideration in siting of units in the 20YA resource expansion plan.

Since this repository is built off of the 2023 ITP version, many items have already been reviewed recently. Review may be focused on the following:

- Appropriateness of retiring sites to be replaced by either wind, solar, battery, CT, CC, or some combination. Please provide any feedback in the “Associated Site Technology” columns.

Other information is provided as reference, but if more accurate data is available, SPP staff will consider edits as they are provided. Some confidential attributes have been omitted from this posting, but SPP staff may use this data in the development of siting criteria and site assignments.

Stakeholders should submit any feedback by **Friday, July 1, 2022** via the SPP Request Management System (RMS), using the “Submit Information” **Request Template**, “Integrated Transmission Planning (ITP)” **Subtype 1**, and “Data Submission” **Subtype 2**”.
