

2022 20-Year Assessment Resource Plan Phase 2 F1/F2

- **Action Required**

SPP Staff is seeking approval of the final 2022 20-Year Assessment (20YA) Resource Plan Phase 2 (RP2) Futures 1 and 2 (F1/F2). The results have been posted to [GlobalScape](#).

- **Entities Required to Provide Feedback**

All interested stakeholders, primarily ESWG members

- **Due Date and Method of Submittal**

A motion for approval will be requested from the ESWG via e-mail to begin the voting process on **Thursday, July 7, 2022.**

- **Changes from Last Pass**

The previous workbook did not reflect the approved 2023 ITP RP2 exceptions that impact AEPW as discussed at the 6/29/22 ESWG meeting. The workbook has also been updated to incorporate Resource Planning Peak Load forecast from the approved 20YA Load Review which reduced regional peak load by ~220 MW. The impacted demand groups include:

- Nebraska Public Power District
- Omaha Public Power District
- Public Service Company of Oklahoma
- Southwestern Electric Power Company

The peak load changes did not affect the total number of conventional resources allocated through the RP2 process for F1 or F2.
