

## 2024 ITP Resource Plan Phase 1 Posting - Update

- **Changes from Last Pass**

The previous workbook did not reflect new ownership changes and a few max capacity updates from the 2024 Generation Review that impacted Resource Plan Phase 1. The areas impacted include:

- Greater Missouri Operations Company
- Westar Energy
- Corn Belt Power Cooperative
- Public Service Company of Oklahoma
- Sunflower Non-Affiliated in SUNC

**These changes did not result in any additional shortfall.**
