RE: Withdrawal of Notification to Construct Approved Reliability Network Upgrades

Dear Mr. Cooley,

Pursuant to Section 3.3 of the Southwest Power Pool, Inc. ("SPP") Membership Agreement and Attachments O and Y of the SPP Open Access Transmission Tariff ("OATT"), on January 12, 2023 SPP issued a Notification to Construct ("NTC") No. 210718 directing Southwestern Public Service Company ("SPS"), as the Designated Transmission Owner, to construct the specified Network Upgrades.

Subsequently, SPP concluded that the Network Upgrade listed below should be withdrawn, and informed the appropriate organizational groups of the withdrawal in accordance with SPP Business Practice 7060 Section 7.1. On February 6, 2024, the SPP Board of Directors approved the Network Upgrade(s) listed below to be withdrawn.
